New Product - Slab Saver Bracket

Connolly are happy to announce the release of the Slab Saver Bracket. This tilt-panel forming bracket saves time and money by eliminating time consuming and costly repairs to fixing holes in the casting slab.

These two piece brackets are made from recycled composite plastic and are lightweight and economical. The bracket is reusable and comes in two sizes to accommodate formwork from 150mm – 250mm forms.

The disposable shoe fits both sizes of bracket and adheres to the concrete, no drilling or other fixings are required. After the tilt panel has been completed and the formwork removed the shoe can simply be removed with a scraper without damage to the casting slab.

The use of Slab Saver Brackets is cost effective and provides a better finish to the completed project.
